**DELTA CONTINUING EDUCATION
FULL CREDIT SUMMER SCHOOL 2018**

Students have an opportunity to complete a secondary course during the summer. This is ideal for those who wish to complete graduation requirements, upgrade a course mark, or lighten next year's academic load.

In the blended program (Planning 10), students will have two—three days per week of classroom based instruction. During non-classroom days, students should be in attendance but working independently.

PREREQUISITES: Students enrolled in secondary school will need International Program approval to ensure prerequisites are in place.

NOTE: Full Credit summer school courses are fast paced and intensive due to the short duration of the course. Students must be able to work independently, be disciplined, and complete assigned homework which supports classroom instruction.

FEE: \$900 (non-refundable) - Picture Identification required
