The Board is having a meeting with stakeholders regarding the funding formula. There will be some news about what they're proposing but we don't know how much is coming our way.

Issues Raised in Groups

- concern about new reporting system and the transition between elementary to high school; it's
 hard to understand where a child is standing in elementary, but much easier with a grade system
 like in high school; it feels like the course correction with the grading system is too far on the
 opposite path now; there's concern over discrepancies between students' grades, where some
 students get the same grade as those who work much harder; concern over the homogenization
 in this new grading system; seems harder to allow children to exceed, but makes sure others
 don't fall through the cracks
- vaping awareness seems to be moving in a positive direction, and education is favored over enforcement
- senior leadership in the Delta School District is outstanding; there's a new EA contract to provide better supports in place now, which keeps EAs in the spot where they are longer
- some schools have high turnover with their leadership positions, and that needs to be dealt with; it's not easy finding and keeping the talent
- playground work is going on; it's a topic of serious discussion
- teacher contracts are also in serious discussions
