

Outside Media in Schools

Media (including radio, television, newspapers, and other print and online media) are sometimes permitted or invited to come to the school or to school activities and allowed to take photos or video or conduct interviews with students, for the purposes of promoting public understanding of school programs, building public support for public education, and encouraging student achievement.

If you do not want your child to be involved in such activities, you need to:

- Tell your child to avoid these situations,
- Tell your child's teacher(s) of your wishes,
- Ask your school for a copy of the *Outside Media Request for Exclusion* form. Complete and return the form to your school to ask the school and school district to take reasonable steps to avoid this type of publication of your child's name, image, or personal information by outside media.

<u>Please note</u>: school and district staff cannot control news media access, photos/videos taken by the media or others in public locations (such as field trips or off school grounds) or school events open to the public, such as sports events, student performances, school board meetings, etc. These are considered public events.
